The Modern Slavery Act 2015 -transparency in supply chains

The Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the Act) is intended to tackle modern slavery by consolidating various offences relating to human trafficking and slavery. It also includes a provision for transparency in supply chains that will require all businesses with an annual turnover of £36 million or more to disclose in an annual slavery and human trafficking statement on their website what steps they have taken during the financial year to ensure their business and supply chains are slavery free.

Xenon Services Ltd do not fit the required criteria and are therefore exempt from producing a slavery and human trafficking statement.
